Volunteer Opportunities: Legacy members may either volunteer at the Resale Shop or with Meals on Wheels. Meals on Wheels is a fun and wonderful mother/daughter volunteer opportunity.

Other Volunteer Programs: Legacy may also be invited to volunteer with other special programs throughout the year. The Service VP will forward emails with information and how to volunteer as needed.

Orientation: All Legacy members and their Moms must attend a one hour orientation session in order to volunteer at either the Resale shop or Meals on Wheels. All volunteers must complete a volunteer form found at <https://www.namonline.org/volunteer> and those 16 years and older will consent to a background check. Copies of driver licenses or school identification cards will be made. Each member should take the Legacy Service Hour Log with them and have a NAM staff member complete it to receive an hour of service for attending the orientation session.

*Orientation is required each new year of volunteering.

Orientation Sessions: Please contact Crystal Ortiz, the volunteer coordinator, to register for an orientation session. The NAM orientations are held the first Wednesday of every month and third Thursday of every month @ 10:00am. The session is in the conference room on the second floor at the NAM main office on Kuykendahl.

Location/Directions: Travel South on Kuykendahl. Crossover FM 1960 and the NAM building is a half a block down on the right. Meals and Wheels door is on the backside of the building.

Age Restriction: Drivers must be 21 years of age. Any Legacy Mom/Parent may drive two Legacy members on a day of volunteering. Drivers must have a valid Texas driver license, proof of insurance, and provide their own car and gas.

Volunteer Opportunities: Meals on Wheels is a home delivery meals program to homebound seniors and individuals who are homebound because of illness or disability. You MUST call to schedule a volunteer day. There are times that volunteers may be needed the day you call. During the summer months, the Service VP may set up a Sign-Up Genius. The link will be emailed to all Legacy Members.

Monday through Saturday 9:00am- 12:00 pm

When volunteers arrive they will sign in on a NAM log and be given a binder with a list of clients and very detailed directions to each client's house. The volunteers will load two large ice chests and two small buckets into their car and then begin to deliver the meals. After completing the route, volunteers will return back to the NAM building to return the binder and the ice chests and buckets. Volunteers are to sign out on the NAM log and also ask the NAM staff member to sign the Legacy Service Hour Log. Saturday volunteers will sign in on the NAM log and then load paper bags of frozen food or groceries into their car. Once deliveries are completed the volunteers do not need to return to NAM. Legacy volunteers need to have the Service Hour Log signed BEFORE leaving NAM to do the deliveries.
