Volunteer Opportunities: Legacy members may volunteer at the home construction site. This activity is a great opportunity for Legacy members to volunteer as a group or individually sign up (with your parent). Please do not volunteer without an adult present.

Age Restrictions for the Home Construction Site:

1. Minimum age to volunteer with Habitat is 16 years of age or older. One Legacy Mom /Parent needs to accompany Legacy youth at a ratio of 1 adult to every 5 youths ages 16-18.
2. Volunteers under the age of 16 cannot climb on a ladder or be on a roof.
3. Volunteers under the age of 18 cannot use power tools, this includes nail guns.

Group Volunteer: Legacy League will arrange for a summer date (TBA) to volunteer as a group for the construction site. We will notify you when a date becomes available. Legacy Service will send an invite through [Sign Up Genius](#) asking for volunteers.

Individual Volunteer: On other days, individual Legacy members are welcome to volunteer by scheduling on your own. To schedule a work day, go to the Northwest Harris County Habitat website (www.habitatnwhc.org), Volunteer tab, then Construction and there will be a link to their [Sign Up Genius](#) at the bottom of the page; <http://www.habitatnwhc.org/volunteer/construction> or email Felicia, the volunteer coordinator.

Dress Code: Volunteers MUST wear closed toed shoes and round collar T-shirts. (Tennis shoes or work boots are preferred.) Mid-thigh shorts or longer Nike shorts are permitted. Jeans and capris are fine to wear however in the summer months volunteers may be too hot and uncomfortable. Volunteers MAY NOT wear tank tops, V-neck T-shirts, blue jean shorts or short shorts. Wear old clothes that you do not mind getting dirty or possibly ruined.

What to bring:

- ❖ All tools and materials will be available on site.
- ❖ Volunteers must bring completed *volunteer waiver.
- ❖ You might also want to bring a pair of work gloves.
- ❖ Water/Gatorade will be provided. Volunteers are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle.
- ❖ DO NOT BRING any valuables.

- ❖ Legacy volunteers should use the Legacy fanny pack to hold the Legacy service hour sheet, car keys, money, identification, and cell phone.

***Volunteer Waiver:** All Legacy volunteers must complete the Habitat Information and Waiver Sheet on a yearly basis. The form is on the Legacy website as well as the Habitat for Humanity website, <http://www.habitatnwhc.org/volunteer/construction>. When Legacy members volunteer at the construction site, a copy of the completed form must be given to the Habitat employee in charge and a copy must be kept with the Legacy Mom volunteer.
